A few things to remember while enjoying your park:

Sites with concrete pads (in L Section) or green-painted pedestals (in E Section) are not available as regular campsites.

Pio Pico allows pressed log campfires, [example: Duraflame], burned only in fire pits that are at least 6 inches off the ground and have a screened lid. Windy or extremely dry conditions may restrict campfires upon recommendation of the California Fire Department. We offer approved fire pits for rent and sell pressed logs for your convenience.

We do not allow washing of any vehicles at Pio Pico.

Kids 5 & under must have adult supervision to use the Youth Center. Kids 14 & under must have adult supervision to use the swimming pool and spa. Helmets are required for kids 17 & under when riding a bicycle, scooter or skateboard! Lights are required when riding at night.

Camping vehicles must be occupied and attended overnight. A \$32 fee per night will be assessed for any left unattended overnight.

Saving or reserving campsites is not allowed.

Pets, remind your humans that you must be on a leash unless you are exercising in the Dog Run and to pick up your waste. Never stay outside by yourself—there are coyotes here!

Help our environment! Recycle aluminum cans and plastic bottles. We have a collection vessel by the Nature Center and in the Activity Center.

We are also GOING GREEN with Comment Cards! Please help us in our conservation effort by using the On Line Comment Card option at www.thousandtrails.com and logging into the Members Only page. No access to the internet? You may request a standard paper version at the Security Station. Your feedback is important, so let us hear from you!

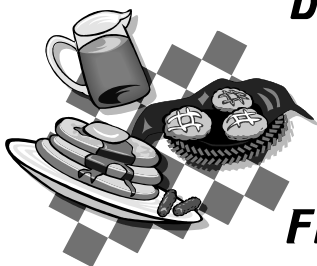
